



What is Cuboree?

- The Victorian Cuboree is a 5 day camp for Cub Scouts, held every three years.
- Held at Gilwell Park, in Gembrook.



Approximately 3,500 Cub Scouts from across Victoria will attend Cuboree 9, 2017. There will be over 1,000 leaders and support staff on site, to look after the Cubs.

What do you do at Cuboree?

- Camp in tents with Cub buddies
 - Pack of 36 Cubs, 7 Leaders & 3 Cooks
- Attend daily activities (8 over 5 days)
- Night time entertainment
- Have loads of fun





Who is Eligible?

Registered Cub Scouts born on or after the 2nd
of October 2006, who have completed the
requirements for the Camp Out Badge

- Must not be aged 11 by Oct 2nd
- Must have Akela and Group Leader approval to attend.
- Must be willing to have fun



What is the Campout Badge?

- During a holiday period, pack a bag for four days/nights duration.
 The Cub Scout is to use only that gear over the four days be aware of the need for good hygiene, storing and packing clothes away.
- Camp out at home either in the backyard or on the floor in a sleeping bag and learn to use their torch to get to the bathroom etc. in the dark.
- Attend two sleep-overs.
- Attend a Pack Holiday under canvas of two consecutive nights' duration
- The Cub Scout is to convey to the Cub Scout Leader that he/she is aware of the need for everyone to carry out good hygiene ethics, eat healthy food, drinks lots of water and report any illnesses or injuries, whilst on pack holidays/camps.



What is the Cost?

- Cub Scout \$400
 - Due by June 30
 - Payment plans available
- \$20 Pack Fee
- \$20 Spending money (optional)

- Spending money \$20 (badges, merchandise)
- Camp stretcher & Sleeping bag

- Medications administered by Leader
- Asthma puffers held by Cubs
- Care Bear castle
- CareMonkey Profile a definite
- Illness just prior to Cuboree

- Parents will be contacted should it be necessary
- Assume 'No news is good news'
- Generally no visitors onsite
